- Nominations for Officers, other members of the Club’s Committee, President and Vice-President are subject to the rules as set out in the Club’s Constitution and as clarified by the Club’s Committee.

- Nominations on the standard form provided must be returned to the Hon. Secretary no later than the **Friday 17th May 2019**, by email, by hand, club desk (Saturday Sessions at TPFC) or post.
- Individuals may nominate themselves and can stand for any or all of the three Officer positions and for being one of the up to eleven other Committee Posts (if an individual is not elected as an Officer they may still wish to be considered for election as a member). If someone is elected as an Officer, then his or her nomination for a Committee Post will be withdrawn.
- All those nominated must be not less than 18 years of age. Any person standing for the Committee must agree to become a Member of the Club, and the Club will enroll them as Members whilst they continue to serve on the Committee, without charge to the Committee Member, but without providing the right to their participation in any swimming activities of the Club. If a Committee Member wishes to participate as a full Member of the Club then they must pay the appropriate fee.
- Those standing may, if they wish, provide a short statement (up to 400 words) to be made available to the membership by the Hon. Secretary before the AGM **no later than 31 May 2019**.
- There is no restriction preventing any coach or teacher paid by the club from being nominated.
- Only full non-junior members (i.e. swimmers aged 18 and over) of the Club and ASA Supporter Members have voting rights at the AGM and can propose and second nominations. Becoming an ASA Supporter member is free and forms can be found here <https://www.teddingtonsc.co.uk/swimmer-info/asa-registration/> (parents of junior members may wish to know that they can join as a Supporter Member on the night of the AGM before the formal business of the meeting begins).
- Presidents and Vice-Presidents have life membership and current Officers and members of the Committee have membership if they are not already full swimming members.
- Officers and other Committee members will be required to abide by the rules of the Constitution and any other requirements agreed by the Committee. In particular they will be required to promptly complete any forms required by Club's Child Protection Officer.
- Individuals standing for election shall be required to declare any conflicts of interest, financial interest or any other relevant matters, on the nomination form, both before their election and then when and as circumstances change or matters arise in Committee. Any financial payment, payment-in-kind or other benefit to a Committee Member should be declared to the Committee.
- Officers and other Committee members should expect to be actively involved in running the club which means taking on roles above any already undertaken for the club, defined by the committee and to support the executive members. They should expect to attend Committee meetings (once a month), and should be willing to have their name, position and contact details publicised by the Club.
